# Girls

<b>Uniform</b>	<b>How To Wear It</b>
<p><u>Jumpers &amp; Skirts:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Grades Y5-3 wear the HFRS plaid uniform jumper.</li> <li>• Grades 4-8 wear the HFRS plaid uniform skirt.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Jumper length and skirt length is to be no shorter than 2 inches above the top of the kneecap.</li> <li>• Skirts cannot be rolled and must be worn at the waist.</li> <li>• The waistband must be visible.</li> <li>• Slacks under the jumper or skirt may be worn to and from school or at recess only.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Slacks:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Grades Y5-8 wear navy blue dress slacks or plaid uniform slacks with front zipper and belt loops.</li> <li>• Must be a Docker, dress twill or corduroy style.</li> <li>• Plain-front and pleated-front slacks are acceptable.</li> <li>• Not permitted: low rise or dropped-hip slacks, capri-style, jean-style, flares, slacks with rivets, and slacks with exterior pockets (i.e. cargo pants).</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must be worn at the waist.</li> <li>• Must be worn with a solid navy, black, or brown belt.</li> <li>• Belt must be visible.</li> <li>• Belts with rivets or grommets are not allowed.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Shorts/Skorts:</u> May 1<sup>st</sup> through September 30<sup>th</sup></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Grades Y5-8 wear navy blue knee-length walking shorts with front zipper and belt loops.</li> <li>• Plain-front and pleated-front slacks are acceptable.</li> <li>• Grades Y5-3 have the option of wearing the navy blue Dennis uniform skort style #035210-965-069.</li> <li>• Not permitted: spandex, cargo shorts, uniform plaid shorts and athletic shorts.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shorts and skorts may be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.</li> <li>• Must be worn at the waist.</li> <li>• Must be worn with a solid navy, black, or brown belt.</li> <li>• Belt must be visible.</li> <li>• Belts with rivets or grommets are not allowed.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Blouses/Shirts:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Grades Y5-8 wear a solid white blouse, white Polo-style shirt, or a solid white turtleneck shirt.</li> <li>• Grades 6-8 also have the option of wearing a solid red Polo-style or turtleneck shirt.</li> <li>• Blouses and Polo-style shirts must button down the front, have a plain collar and may be long or short sleeved.</li> <li>• Peter Pan collar and oxford style blouses are acceptable.</li> <li>• Turtleneck shirts must have a rolled neck and may be short or long sleeved.</li> <li>• The only logo permitted is the HFRS cross logo.</li> <li>• Not permitted: mock turtleneck, shirts with ornamentation.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shirt must be tucked into the slacks with the waistband visible.</li> <li>• Only the top button of the shirt may be unbuttoned.</li> <li>• Solid white, short sleeved t-shirt or undershirt may be worn underneath uniform shirt.</li> <li>• Undershirt sleeves should not extend beyond the sleeve of the uniform shirt.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Sweaters:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Grades Y5-8 may wear a solid navy, red, or white sweaters.</li> <li>• Cardigans, vests, crewneck and v-neck pullover styles are acceptable.</li> <li>• Sweaters may have the HFRS cross logo only.</li> <li>• Not permitted: hooded, striped, floral, and multi-colored design sweaters.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A blouse, Polo-style shirt, or turtleneck must be worn under the sweater.</li> </ul>

## Girls

<b>Uniform</b>	<b>How To Wear It</b>
<p><u>Sweatshirts:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Grades Y5-8 may wear the HFRS uniform navy blue sweatshirt with the HFRS cross logo.</li> <li>• Grade 8 may wear the class sweatshirt.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A blouse, Polo-style shirt, or turtleneck must be worn under the sweatshirt.</li> <li>• Sweatshirts with the Wildcat logo are not to be worn during the school day.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Socks/Tights:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Grades Y5-8 wear solid white or navy crew socks, knee socks, or tights.</li> <li>• Crew socks should be above the ankle and able to fold over.</li> <li>• Not permitted: Socks or tights displaying a manufacturer's logo. Over-the-knee, over-the-thigh, argyle, lacy, frilled, patterned or print socks or tights. Footies, ankle socks, or running socks.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Socks must be worn and visible at all times.</li> <li>• Only one pair of socks may be worn at a time.</li> <li>• Crew socks must be worn with tennis shoes.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Shoes:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Solid black, brown or navy leather or suede dress shoes that are closed at the toe and heel.</li> <li>• Not permitted: Shoes with heels over one inch, platforms, sandals, clogs, moccasins, or shoes with built-in wheels.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shoes with laces should be tied.</li> <li>• Tennis shoes may be worn with the navy blue uniform shorts.</li> <li>• On gym days, grades Y5-5 may wear tennis shoes or athletic shoes for the entire day.</li> <li>• Boots are to be worn to and from school or at recess only.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Accessories:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A simple cross or religious medal with chain, a wristwatch, or one modest ring is permitted.</li> <li>• WWJD bracelets are the only bracelets allowed.</li> <li>• One pair of small earrings (such as studs) may be worn.</li> <li>• Headbands and barrettes must be solid red, white, navy, brown, black, or uniform plaid.</li> <li>• Not permitted: multiple or dangling/hoop earrings.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Earrings must be worn on earlobe.</li> <li>• All accessories should be free of ornamentation.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Hair and Make-Up:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hair must be a natural color as well as neat and clean at all times.</li> <li>• Grade 8 may wear light natural looking make-up including natural lip-gloss, light blush, lightly applied mascara, and clear nail polish.</li> <li>• Not permitted: Make-up or nail polish in grades Y5-7, glitter, unnatural, or heavy make-up, excessive fad haircuts or styles.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hairstyle is not to be a distraction.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Gym Uniforms:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Grades 4-8 wear a gym uniform for gym class.</li> <li>• White t-shirt with logo and blue shorts with logo must be ordered through the school.</li> <li>• Tennis shoes and socks are required for gym.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Uniforms are ordered at the end of the year for the subsequent year and are distributed to the students in the fall during the first gym class.</li> <li>• Sample gym uniforms will be available in the school offices to help determine appropriate sizes.</li> </ul>

## Girls

<b>Uniform</b>	<b>How To Wear It</b>
<p><u>Non-Uniform Days:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Appropriate non-uniform dress is to be worn.</li> <li>• Not permitted: Flip-flops, sandals, tank tops and short tops with the midriff showing, low-rise or dropped-hip slacks, yoga pants, logos on seat of pants, ripped or torn clothing, dangling/hoop earrings, tight or revealing attire. If leggings are worn, the shirt/top must be no shorter than mid-thigh. Clothing with inappropriate ads or promotions for music groups, movies, television shows, etc. that promote actions contrary to HFRS policies.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Usually scheduled approximately once per month.</li> <li>• Parents should carefully scrutinize shirts and pants with mottos, graphics, and ads.</li> <li>• Slacks and shorts must be worn at the waist.</li> <li>• Shorts and skorts must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.</li> <li>• Shorts, capris and skorts are permitted May 1<sup>st</sup> through September 30<sup>th</sup>.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Dress Up Days:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clothes that are appropriate for a “better” occasion.</li> <li>• Appropriate clothes might be: dresses, skirts, nice slacks, and dress shoes.</li> <li>• Not permitted: jeans, tennis shoes, flip-flops, shorts, skorts, tight or revealing attire.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Designated dress-up days are usually the first day of school and the last day of school.</li> <li>• Dress sandals are permitted May 1<sup>st</sup> through September 30<sup>th</sup>.</li> </ul>

# Boys

<b>Uniform</b>	<b>How To Wear It</b>
<p><u>Slacks:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Grades Y5-8 wear navy blue dress slacks with front zipper and belt loops.</li> <li>Must be a Dockers-type, dress twill or corduroy style.</li> <li>Plain-front and pleated-front slacks are acceptable.</li> <li>Not permitted: jean-style, flares, slacks with rivets, and slacks with exterior pockets (i.e. cargo pants).</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must be worn at the waist.</li> <li>Must be worn with a solid navy, black, or brown belt.</li> <li>Belt must be visible.</li> <li>Belts with rivets or grommets are not allowed.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Shorts:</u> (May 1<sup>st</sup> through September 30<sup>th</sup>)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Grades Y5-8 wear navy blue knee-length walking shorts with front zipper and belt loops.</li> <li>Plain-front and pleated-front slacks are acceptable.</li> <li>Not permitted: spandex, cargo shorts, and athletic shorts.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must be worn at the waist.</li> <li>Must be worn with a solid navy, black, or brown belt.</li> <li>Belt must be visible.</li> <li>Belts with rivets or grommets are not allowed.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Shirts:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Grades Y5-8 wear a solid white Polo-style shirt, a solid white oxford cloth shirt, or a solid white turtleneck shirt.</li> <li>Grades 6-8 also have the option of wearing a solid red Polo-style or turtleneck shirt.</li> <li>Oxford cloth and Polo-style shirts must button down the front, have a collar and may be long or short sleeved.</li> <li>Turtleneck shirts must have a rolled neck and may be short or long sleeved.</li> <li>The only logo permitted is the HFRS cross logo.</li> <li>Not permitted: mock turtleneck.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Shirt must be tucked into the slacks with the waistband visible.</li> <li>Only the top button of the shirt may be unbuttoned.</li> <li>Solid white, short sleeved t-shirt or undershirt may be worn underneath uniform shirt.</li> <li>Undershirt sleeves should not extend beyond the sleeve of the uniform shirt.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Sweaters:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Grades Y5-8 may wear a solid navy, red, or white sweaters.</li> <li>Cardigans, vests, crewneck and v-neck pullover styles are acceptable.</li> <li>Sweaters may have the HFRS cross logo only.</li> <li>Not permitted: hooded, striped, or multi-colored design sweaters.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>An oxford cloth shirt, Polo-style shirt, or turtleneck must be worn under the sweater.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Sweatshirts:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Grades Y5-8 may wear the HFRS uniform navy blue sweatshirt with the HFRS cross logo.</li> <li>Grade 8 may wear the class sweatshirt.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>An oxford cloth shirt, Polo-style shirt, or turtleneck must be worn under the sweatshirt.</li> <li>Sweatshirts with the Wildcat logo are not to be worn during the school day.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Socks:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Grades Y5-8 wear solid white or navy crew socks.</li> <li>Crew socks should be above the ankle and able to fold over.</li> <li>Not permitted: Socks displaying a manufacturer's logo. Argyle, patterned or print socks. Footies, ankle socks, or running socks.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Socks must be worn and visible at all times.</li> <li>Only one pair of socks may be worn at a time.</li> <li>Crew socks must be worn with tennis shoes.</li> </ul>

# Boys

<b>Uniform</b>	<b>How To Wear It</b>
<p><u>Shoes:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Solid black, brown or navy leather or suede dress shoes that are closed at the toe and heel.</li> <li>• Not permitted: sandals, clogs, moccasins or shoes with built-in wheels.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shoes with laces should be tied.</li> <li>• Tennis shoes may be worn with the navy blue uniform shorts.</li> <li>• On gym days, grades Y5-5 may wear tennis shoes or athletic shoes for the entire day.</li> <li>• Boots are to be worn to and from school or at recess only.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Accessories:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A simple cross or religious medal with chain, a wristwatch, or one modest ring is permitted.</li> <li>• WWJD bracelets are the only bracelets allowed.</li> <li>• Ties can be worn on dress-up days only.</li> <li>• Not permitted: earrings</li> </ul>	
<p><u>Hair:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hair must be a natural color as well as neat and clean at all times.</li> <li>• Boys' haircuts must be above the collar, ears, and eyebrows.</li> <li>• Not permitted: excessive fad haircuts or styles.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hairstyle is not to be a distraction.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Gym Uniforms:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Grades 4-8 wear a gym uniform for gym class.</li> <li>• White t-shirt with logo and blue shorts with logo must be ordered through the school.</li> <li>• Tennis shoes and socks are required for gym.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Uniforms are ordered at the end of the year for the subsequent year and are distributed to the students in the fall during the first gym class.</li> <li>• Sample gym uniforms will be available in the school offices to help determine appropriate sizes.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Non-Uniform Days:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Appropriate non-uniform dress is to be worn.</li> <li>• Not permitted: Tank tops, flip-flops, sandals, ripped or torn clothing. Clothing with inappropriate ads or promotions for music groups, movies, television shows, etc. that promote actions contrary to HFRS policies.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Usually scheduled approximately once per month.</li> <li>• Parents should carefully scrutinize shirts and pants with mottos, graphics, and ads.</li> <li>• Slacks and shorts must be worn at the waist.</li> <li>• Shorts are permitted May 1<sup>st</sup> through September 30<sup>th</sup>.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Dress Up Days:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clothes that are appropriate for a "better" occasion.</li> <li>• Appropriate clothes might be: collared Polo-style shirt, dress shirt, tie, nice pants, dress shorts, jacket, and dress shoes.</li> <li>• Not permitted: jeans, cargo shorts, sandals.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Designated dress-up days are usually the first day of school and the last day of school.</li> <li>• Belts must be visible.</li> <li>• Dress shorts are permitted May 1<sup>st</sup>-September 30<sup>th</sup>.</li> </ul>
